**Children's Safe Harbor** provides safe visitation exchange services. Our goal is to lessen the harmful effects of domestic violence for both adult and child victims through programming that is provided in a safe and supportive environment in which abusive behavior is acknowledged while promoting relationships between parents and children without risk of fear, intimidation and post-separation abuse.

Families enrolled in **Children's Safe Harbor's** services can be ordered from the court, referred by an agency or self-request use of services. Priority is given to residents of Winnebago County and there are no fees to utilize services. Families may utilize Children's Safe Harbor as long as necessary.

Parents interested in accessing **Children's Safe Harbor** must complete an intake and orientation with staff before beginning services.

**Children's Safe Harbor** is open for visitation exchanges:

- Wednesdays 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM
- Fridays 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM
- Saturdays 8:00 AM to Noon,  
5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
- Sundays 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM

**Children's Safe Harbor** is funded by a combination of private donations and public funding. Public funding for Children's Safe Harbor is provided through civil filing fees of the residents of Winnebago County, Illinois.
