Impact

In 2024, Children's Safe Harbor provided 583 Supervised Visits and 809 Safe Exchanges.

To enhance safety and well-being for children and parents by providing child-centered trauma-informed supervised visitation and safe exchange services.

For children and parents to be safe and free from victimization and trauma during parenting time exchanges and supervised parenting time.
